IMPORTANT NOTES:
STAR 1 EVENTS:
A coach will lead an off-ice warm-up in the (meet outside dressing rooms) and skaters will be released from warm-up 15 minutes before their on-ice time to put their skates on.
STAR 2 FREESKATE EVENTS:
A coach will lead an off-ice warm-up in the (meet outside dressing rooms) and skaters will be released from warm-up 15 minutes before their on-ice time to put their skates on.
STAR 3 AND UP FREESKATE, PLUS ALL ELEMENT & TEAM ELEMENTS EVENTS:
There will be no coach led off-ice warm-up. Skaters in those levels are expected to conduct an independent off-ice warm-up.
ADDITIONAL NOTES:
S2+ skaters are required to give their flash drive to the Ice Captain before stepping onto the ice for their warm-up. While skaters would normally hand their flash drive to their primary coach at the start of their on-ice warm-up, this Simulation is an exception, as coaches will be rinkside throughout the event. Parents are strongly encouraged to assist younger or newer skaters with following the schedule to ensure they are on time for their event. Locations and schedule subject to change.
